## a) Coal Sample:

Moisture, Ash, Volatile Matter, Gross Calorific Value, Total Sulfur, Relative Density, Chlorine, Carbon (total), Hydrogen, Nitrogen, Carbonate Carbon, Phosphorus in Coal, Pyritic Sulfur, Sulfate Sulfur, Trace Elements – Fluorine, Mercury, Selenium, Arsenic, Boron, Cadmium, Antimony and CSN/FSI.

# b) Coal Ash Sample:

Ash Fusion (Reducing and Oxidising Atmosphere) - Deformation Temperature, Spherical Temperature, Hemisphere Temperature, Flow Temperature.

Ash Constituents – Silicon as  $SiO_2$ , Aluminium as  $Al_2O_3$ , Iron as  $Fe_2O_3$ , Calcium as CaO, Magnesium as MgO, Manganese as  $Mn_3O_4$ , Potassium as  $K_2O$ , Sodium as  $Na_2O$ , Titanium as  $TiO_2$ , Phosphorus as  $P_2O_5$ , Sulfur as  $SO_3$ , Barium as BaO, Strontium as SrO, Zinc as ZnO.
